






The Commission took suo motu cognizance on a news item appearing in Ananda Bazar Patrika dt.19/9/2020 captioned “পুলিশ ফাঁড়ির কাছে তোলাবাজদের মার” Report was called for from Commissioner of Police, Howrah Police Commissionerate. The matter was enquired into by A.C.P. and report forwarded to Commission by Commissioner of Police, Howrah Commissionerate.

During the course of the enquiry the person named in the news item, Sanjib Kumar was called by the E.O. but as he was away in Bihar his brother, Rajib Kumar Shaw met the enquiring officer. According to him, on 17/9/2020 while Ram Narayan Shaw father of Sanjib Kumar had shop, namely, Sri Ganesh Stationery Stores situated at 170, Mahendra Bhattacharjee Road, P.S.Chatterjeehat, two persons, namely, Amitabh and his associates asked for purchase of goods on credit. As RamNarayan Shaw refused they used filthy language and assaulted the shopkeeper and his son, Sanjib Kumar. Over this incident Chatterjeehat P.S. Case No.123/20 dt.17/9/2020 u/s 341/325/427/506/34 IPC was started against the accused persons and charge sheet no.126/2020 dt.31/10/2020 was submitted against them. The matter is now sub judice. The allegation leveled about illegal extortion in the newspaper report could not be substantiated hence, it appears to be incorrect. As adequate action has been taken by police there is no violation of Human Rights u/s 12(a)(i)(ii) hence, the matter be filed.
