

Justice N. C. Sil, Member of the West Bengal Human Rights Commission had visited Contai State Welfare Home, Purba Medinipur on 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2013.

The Commission then made the following recommendations to the State Government: -

- i) Provision for recreation and extra curricular activities and vocational training on regular basis should be immediately introduced.
- ii) The Government may take appropriate steps as regards posting of proper Night Guard in the Home.
- iii) The inmates of the Home should be provided proper accommodation in the Hall.
- iv) The dining Hall is required to be properly equipped as there is no provision for sitting arrangement.
- v) The kitchen should be renovated with the provision for as for the purpose of cooking.
- vi) There must be provision for posting of a permanent doctor or at least regular visit of a doctor in the said Home.

- vii) The broken boundary wall should be repaired immediately in order to prevent the apprehension of escape from the Home.

By a letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2014, an action taken report was submitted to the Commission.
