

An application was filed before the Commission by one Haru Roy in which he alleged that “in the early morning of 29.10.10 his brother Rajesh Roy was admitted in Rampurhat Hospital with severe pain in abdomen. While his brother was in the hospital three-four people forcibly took away Rajesh from the bed and killed him by hitting on his forehead. The dead body of Rajesh was recovered from the passage of third floor of the said hospital. For such incident the petitioner made GDA, Night-guard, Ward-Master and Attending Physician of that hospital responsible.

The Commission taking cognizance of the matter called for a report from the Superintendent of Police, Birbhum. A report from the Superintendent of Police, Birbhum was sent to the Commission stating that as the petitioner could not produce any proof that he had submitted any complaint with Rampurhat P.S., he was advised to file a fresh complaint on the basis of which a specific case was started.

A status report was called for by the Commission in respect of the said specific case wherein it was stated that the Superintendent of Rampurhat S. D. Hospital was not cooperating with Rampurhat P.S. in the investigation. Subsequently the Commission examined the then Superintendent of Police, Birbhum and the Officer-in Charge concerned, Ujjal Banerjee. On hearing the said police personnel and considering the materials on record the Commission passed the following recommendation:-

1. that departmental proceedings be initiated against Sri Ujjal Banerjee, new I/C, Diamond Harbour P.S.

2. that a sum of Rs. 40,000/- be paid to the petitioner Haru Roy as compensation and the same be realized from the salary of Sri Ujjal Banerjee.

By a letter dated 12th August, 2015, the Commission received an action taken report from the Government.
