A Radiogram Message vide Signal No. 1588/RB dated 06.03.17 has been received from the Superintendent, Dum Dum Central Correctional Home, intimating custodial death of one Bangladeshi Convict, namely, Golam Rosui, aged about 31 years, son of Rejaul Islam of Khajadanga, PS-Rupsa, Dist. Khulna, Bangladesh at R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital on 05.03.2017 at about 07:40 P.M. It is also reported that he was shifted to that Correctional Home from Basirhat Sub Correctional Home on the ground of overcrowding.

The Dy. Commissioner of Police, North Division is directed to make an enquiry and submit report to this Commission within four weeks from the date of communication of this direction. Also intimate whether an enquiry under Section 176(1-A(a) of Cr.PC has been held by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, if so a copy thereof be sent.

ADG Correctional Services, West Bengal is directed to submit a detailed report along with copy of Post Mortem and Magisterial Inquest report etc., to this Commission within four weeks from the date of communication of this direction.



An intimation was received from Superintendent, Dum Dum Central Correctional Services intimating custodial death of one Bangladesi national, namely, Golam Rosui (31 years) resident of P.S.Rupsa. Dist-Khulna, Bandladesh at R.G. Kar Medical College and Hospital on 05/3/2017. He was shifted from Basirhat Sub Correctional Home due to overcrowding. Reports were called for from A.D.G., Correctional Services regarding this custodial death. Reports have since been received and according to the post mortem report, death was due to effects of diseased condition of liver, a natural cause. No injuries were noticed during the inquest carried out by Special Executive Magistrate, North & North Suburban Division, Kolkata. As the death was due to natural causes I am of the view the matter be filed.


