
A Radiogram Message vide Org. No. 174/AB dated 15.07.17 has been received from the Superintendent, Siliguri Special Correctional Home, intimating custodial death of one Convict Prisoner Patient, namely, Madhab Modak, son of Late Banka Bihari Modak, aged about 70 years, R/O Pakhihaga, PS- Dinhata, Dist. Cooch Behar at North Bengal Medical College & Hospital on 15.07.2017 at around 01:15 Hrs. It is also reported that he was shifted to that Correctional Home from Jalpaiguri Central Correctional Home for better medical facilities.

The Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate is directed to cause an enquiry and to submit a report within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order. Also intimate whether an inquiry under Section 176(1-A)(a) of Cr.P.C. has been held by Ld. Judicial Magistrate, if so a copy thereof be sent.

ADG, Correctional Services, West Bengal is directed to submit a detailed report along with copy of Post Mortem and Magisterial Inquest report etc., to this Commission within the aforesaid period.

system, a natural cause.
