This direction is to be communicated forthwith.





It appears from the copy of the Magisterial Inquest report that no mark of injury was found in the body of the deceased.

It appears from the copy of the P.M. report that the death was due to the effects of diseased conditions of the body involving vital organs as noted therein and the further opinion, if any, is reserved till receipt of the chemical examination report.



The communication of NHRC dt.03/10/17 indicates that they wanted to know the status within four days from State Human Rights Commission. Nearly 1 ½ years have passed since then and NHRC has made no further communication whether they have dropped the matter or otherwise. Meanwhile, Superintendent, Alipore Correctional Home has entered into direct correspondence with Chairman, N.H.R.C. FSL report awaited despite several reminders.


