

The report forwarded by D.C.P (S.E.D) Kolkata does not contain legible copy of Magisterial Inquest Report with regard to the custodial death of UTP Kampana Chandra but the said copy as well as copy of the P.M. report forwarded by Superintendent Alipore Central Correctional Home are very much legible.

It appears from the <sup>copy of</sup> Magisterial Inquest report that only oozing out of some brown coloured fluid was found out in ~~coming out from~~ the mouth of the dead body at the time of inquest but no externally visible wound was observed in the body of the deceased.

It appears from the copy of P.M. report that death was due to the effects of the diseased condition as noted therein - a natural cause.

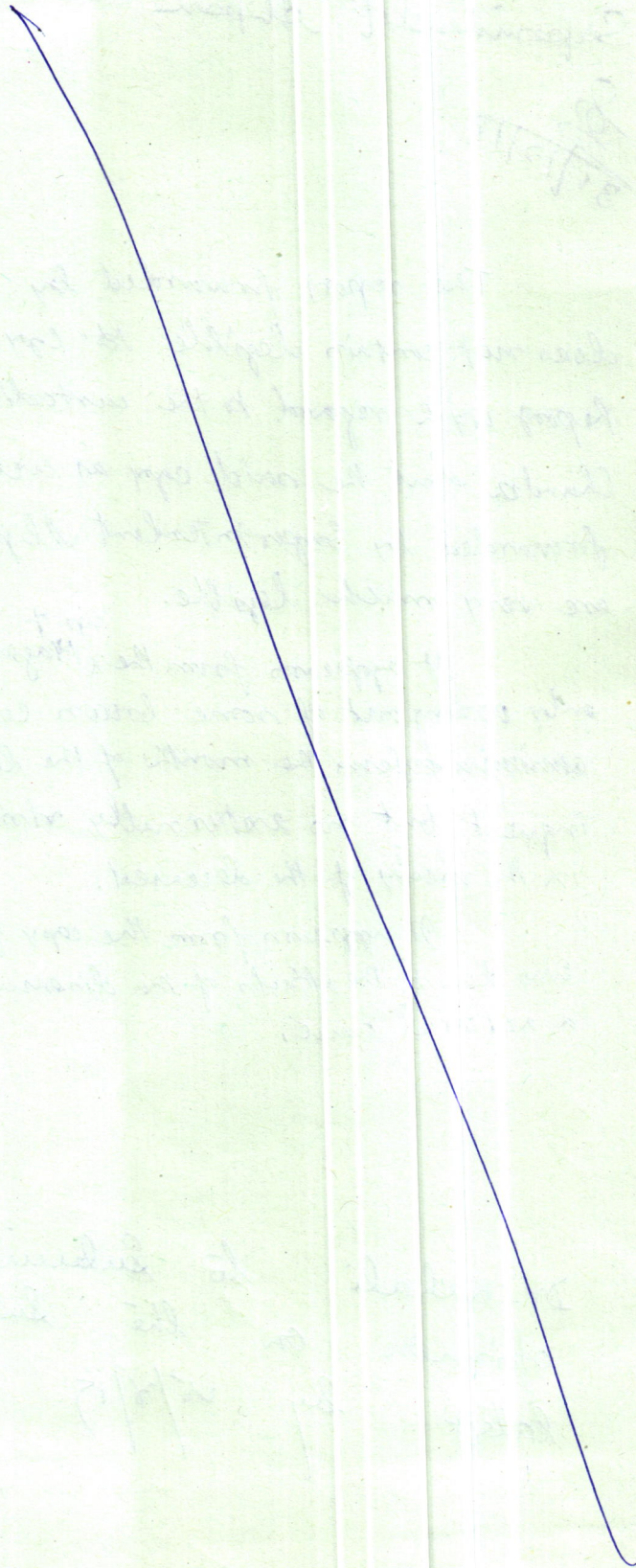

The copy of the Magisterial Inquest Report submitted in this case indicated that some brown colour fluid was found in the mouth of the dead body and at the time of Inquest the same was oozing out.

Considering such description, the Hon'ble Commission was pleased to direct Dr. B. M. Kahali to submit his opinion on the subject matter as stated above.

In compliance with such order Dr. B. M. Kahali has submitted his opinion stating that the deceased was suffering from diseased condition of the lungs and pleura which was sufficient to cause the death in the ordinary course of nature and stated the death was caused purely due to natural cause. However according to him, the opinion about the cause of death can be given in a confirmatory and full proof manner only on the basis of FSL report.

It may be mentioned that the FSL report is not available till now.


