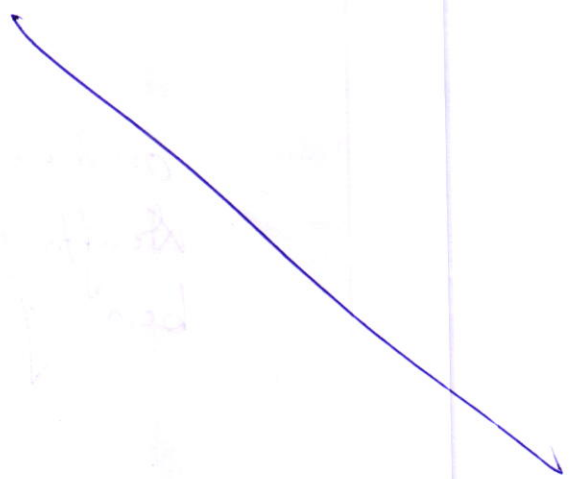

However the copies of Magisterial Inquest report and P.M. report in respect of the custodial death of UTP Hardhan Mahato are enclosed with the said reports.

It appears from the copy of Magisterial Inquest report that no visible external injury was found in the body of the deceased but brown coloured stained <sup>marks</sup> of fluid was found at the sides of lower lips.

It appears from the P.M. report that death was due to the effects of the diseased condition as noted therein — a natural cause
