Also intimate whether Judicial enquiry under Section 176 (1A)(a) of Cr.P.C. has been held by Ld. Judicial Magistrate, if so a copy thereof be sent.

The D.C. Correctional Services was also directed to submit a detailed report along with copies of P.M report and Magisterial Inquest report.

On 17.04.18 The Superintendent Presidency Correctional Home sent a report enclosing ^{copy of} Magisterial Inquest report and P.M. report.

It appears from the copy of the Magisterial Inquest report that saliva was there in the ~~no~~ left nose of the deceased and there was no abrasion mark on the left knee joints.

It appears from the copy of the P.M. report that death was due to effects of diseased condition involving vital organs as noted hereto and further opinion is reserved till receiving of chemical examination report.

On 27.06.18 D.C.P (South Division) also forwarded a report informing that Magisterial Enquiry was done by empowered Executive Magistrate D.C.P. (1) Apart ~~from~~ from ^{the} copy of Magisterial Inquest report and P.M. report, the ^{copy of} Viscera report and Magisterial Enquiry ~~are~~ are enclosed with the said report forwarded on 27.06.18.

It appears from the copy of the Viscera Examination report that no poison could be detected in the viscera or in the blood of the deceased.

It appears from the copy of the Magisterial Enquiry report that the death was caused due to illness and there was no ~~any~~ custodial violence nor there was any negligence on the part of the custodial authority.
