The opinion of Dr. B. N. Kahali dt 12-2-19 reveals that there is nothing to add or delete to the opinion as expressed by autopsy surgeon that the cause of death of Subhojit Das @ Prokash (46 yr) Hindu male was due to effect of cardiocirculatory due to long and given the natural diseased condition of organ. There is no evidence of any external or internal injury over the body of the deceased. There is no evidence of torture over the body of the deceased. Opinion about the cause of death in a confirmatory and foolproof manner can be given after perusal of histopathological report and FSL report which is lodged in the file.
