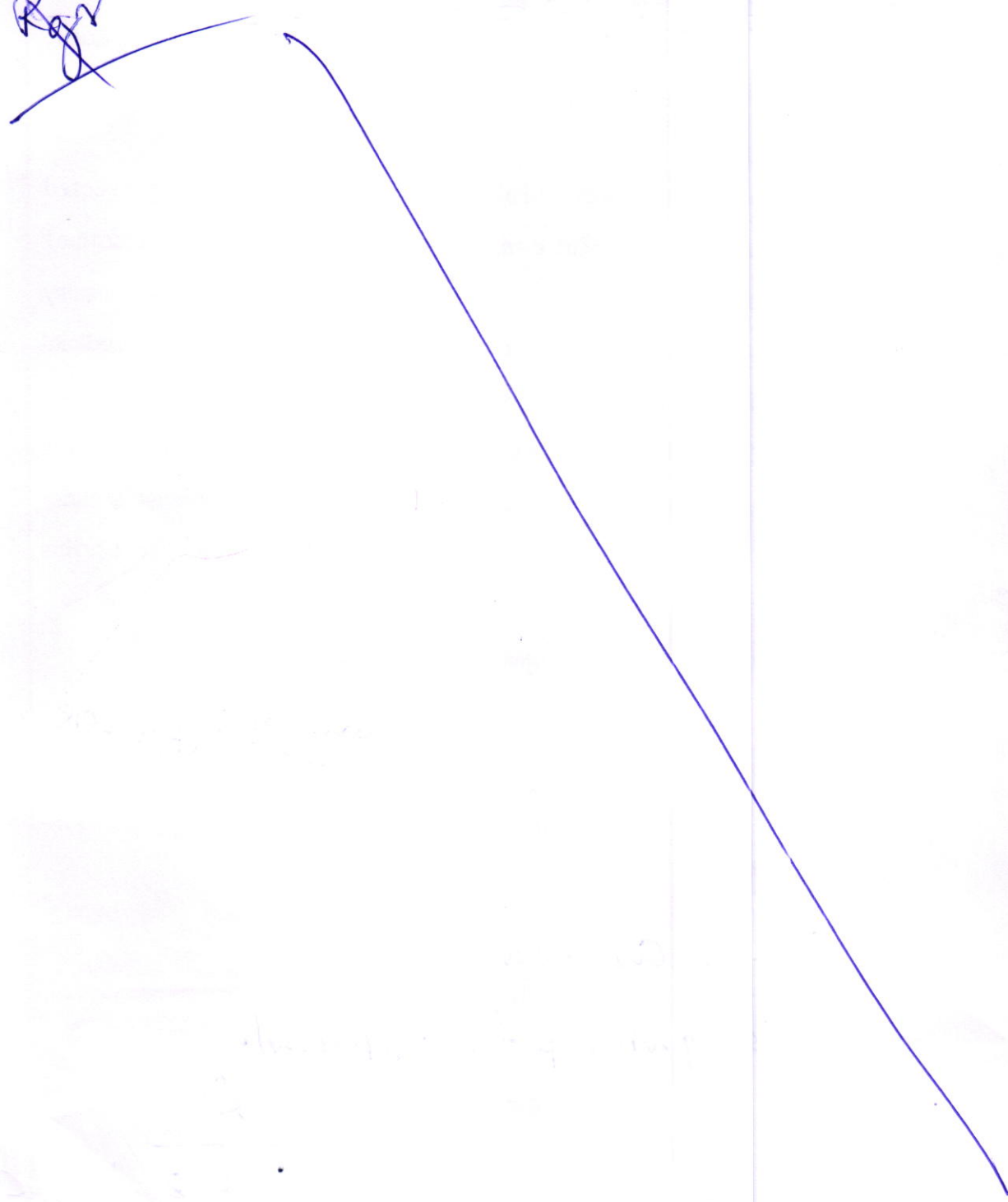

On 17.04.18 D.C.P (S.S.D), Kolkata and D.O. Correctional Services West Bengal were directed to submit their respective reports with regard to the custodial death of an UTP namely Dilip Sarkar along with specific information / copies of documents indicated in the order dated 17.04.18.

On 09.08.18 D.C.P. (S.S.D), Kolkata forwarded a report along with copies of death certificate, P.M. report and Magisterial Inquest report.

Nothing has been indicated with regard to cause of death in the death certificate.

Apart from bleed <sup>of the body of the deceased</sup> on the back, no other mark of injury was found at the time of Magisterial Inquest.

As per P.M. report death was due to effects of diseased condition of organs as described therein and further opinion is reserved till receipt of chemical examiner's report and histopathological report.

It is further indicated in the forwarded report that viscera<sup>2</sup> report, Magisterial Inquest report and Pinal Opinion on cause of death are still pending
