Chandannagar Sub correctional Home  
dt 19-2-20 reveals that Ad Judicial  
Magistrate 3rd Court Chandannagar  
held magistrate enquiry in respect  
of death of UTP Ismail Ali Mollah  
According to report of Ad Magistrate  
deceased accused Ismail Ali Mollah was

Received at UTP by the Correctional Home Chandannagar on 1-12-19 as per order of 1st ADGM Court Chandannagar after Medical check up. Thereafter as per Telephonic Direction of DIG and suggestion of medical officer of Chittaranjan Ptraimbari Hospital he was sent to Bandwan Correctional Home for better treatment. The Controller of Chandannagar Correctional Home stated that he accused was received by him on 27.12.19. After taking Snacks he accused fell ill at about 8:10 p.m.

He was taken to Chandannagar Hospital and declared dead by the M.O. The Controller Chandannagar Correctional Home stated that he accused Ismail Ali Mollah was received by him on 27-12-19 and there was no communication from Head of Bandwan Correctional Home regarding the health condition of the accused Ismail Ali Mollah who was sent there only for better treatment.

During enquiry the Controller stated that the deceased UTP Ismail Ali Mollah was suffering from heart and kidney disease. The next date for check up in Bandwan Medical College is 28.12.19. So no medical papers were sent from Bandwan Correctional Home to his end. UTP Tanvir Morsed Mollah and Tanjut Morsed Mollah who are sons of Ismail Ali Mollah stated that they were arrested on the same date and their father was suffering from High blood sugar and heart disease.

The Medical Officer Debasish

Sarkar Bandwan Medical College and Hospital stated that accused Ismail Ali Mollah had swelling symptom. He also stated that he accused had the complaint of pain in chest and shortness of breath also. Date for further check up was fixed after two weeks. The Medical Officer also stated that the accused had heart related problem.

The Autopsy Surgeon Dr Jayanta Mishra was interrogated and he has stated that he performed autopsy of dead body of deceased Ismail Ali Mollah and the reason of death is due to the effect of changes in heart, kidney, and lungs which are ante mortem in nature and natural in cause. He stated that the deceased was suffering from diseases of heart, lung, kidney for a long time.

Ld Magistrate opined in her report that from the version of medical experts. The accused Ismail Ali Mollah was under treatment. Therefore although the death of the accused Ismail Ali Mollah was natural but still the question of proper medical facility at proper time is indeed an issue.
