A Radiogram Message vide no.1886/AB Dated :02.07.2019 has been received from the Superintendent, Bankura District Correctional Home, intimating custodial death of one male UTP namely Gopal Mondal S/O Lt. Kinkar Mondal, age about 68 years of Vill-Churamonipur, P.S. Onda, Dist Bankura, who was declared brought dead by the attending Medical Officer of BSMC&H, Bankura on 01.07.2019 at 7.55 p.m.

The Superintendent of Police, Bankura is directed to cause an enquiry and to submit a report within four weeks from the date of communication of this order and to intimate whether enquiry by Judicial Magistrate has been done under section 176(1-A)(a) of Cr.P.C. In case it has been done a legible copy be sent. In case it has not been done, the reason therefor should be informed.

ADG, Correctional Services, West Bengal is directed to submit a detailed report along with copy of Post Mortem report and Magisterial Inquest report etc. within four weeks from the date of communication of this direction.

This direction is to be communicated forthwith.

Bankura Dt Correctional Home dt
19-7-2020 reveals that UTP Gopal
Mondal Spolt Kinkar Mondal expired
on 7-7-2019 at about 7.55 PM at Bankura
Sanmitoni Medical College & Hospital. He
became sick on 1-7-2019 evening and
admitted in Bankura Sanmitoni Medical
College and Hospital. UTP Gopal Mondal

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was declared brought dead by the medical officer. Thereafter UD case no 470/19 dt 1-7-19 started. Inquest accordingly done and Post mortem of the deceased Gopal Mandal (68 yrs) done accordingly. AS per PM report due to advanced degree of decomposition and absence of any fatal injury no opinion can be given regarding the cause of death. Further opinion can be given only after receipt of FSL Report. According to FSL report the presence of any toxic substance could not be detected in the contents of the Exhibit Marked 'A' at the stage of forensic Toxicological examination. Ld Judicial Magistrate 7th Court Bankura also held Judicial Enquiry as per provision 75176 of CrPC. According to the report of Ld JM Kousik Kundu 7th Court Bankura no foul play appears relating to the death of UTP Gopal Mandal (Report dt 18-11-19).
