In inviting your kind attention to the above-mentioned subject and reference, I am directed to state that the recommendation of the Commission on the incident of spurious liquor death in Diamond Harbour Subdivision in South 24 Parganas district has been carefully examined by the Govt. along with related papers.

After careful consideration of all matters Govt. has concluded that Shri Deb Kumar Chakraborty, Excise Commissioner can not be held personally liable for the violation of human rights in the instant case. It is the view of the Government that no single person could be held personally responsible for the tragedy. However the Government has initiated several steps to ensure that such a tragedy does not occur again.

Accordingly, I am directed to inform that the Govt. has decided to initiate no disciplinary proceeding against Shri Deb Kumar Chakraborty, Excise Commissioner.
