

On 28.06.17 a news was published in the Bengali Daily "Bi Samay" with regard to callousness of the people about the distress of a person who was found lying on footpath in unconscious condition.

Considering the gravity of the said incident, the Bench Commission was pleased to take cognizance and a report was called for from C.P. Barrackpore.

It is reported that during enquiry it was learnt that on 17.06.17 Dum Dum PS received information that an unknown person was lying on footpath opposite to Saragachi Garden and after arrival at the spot police found that an unknown person was lying there in unconscious condition. At that time one person namely Sujay Dutta came forward and identified the aforesaid unconscious person as Chandan Basu of 12/12, Dakhinpara Road, Kolkata-28 and thereafter with the help of local people he took him to Dum Dum Municipal Hospital where he was declared as brought dead. The attending MO of the hospital issued a letter addressing to OC, Dum Dum PS for taking necessary action to ascertain the actual cause of death and accordingly, Dum Dum PS UD Case No. 79/17 dt. 17.06.17 was recorded. After preparing inquest report police sent the dead body at Barrackpore Police Morgue for holding PM examination by autopsy surgeon who opined that "Death was due to the effect of the diseased condition of his lungs as stated above - a natural cause".

It is further reported that Sujoy Dutta, the relative of the deceased Chandan Basu also declared in writing that police personnel of Dum Dum PS cooperated with them during the period of incident and they have no complaint against anyone.
