Students taken ill after eating mid-day meal

Those who fell ill were rushed to Murshidabad Medical College and Hospital at Behrampore

BEHRAMPORE, 4 MAY

At least 50 students of a primary school fell sick soon after taking mid day meals

here today.

Students of Shishu Shiksha Kendra at Solua area within Behrampore police station limits in Murshidabad complained of gastro ailment immediately after they ate rice and potato curry, said SSK officials.

Some of the students also vomited at the school while several others showed signs of giddiness, sources said. Those who fell ill at the co-educational SSK were rushed to Murshidabad Medical College and Hospital at Behrampore. About 20 students were discharged after first-aid while the rest are still under treatment. It is suspected to be a case of food contamination but things need to be inquired into, said education department officials here.
