On 13.01.19, a news was published in Ananda Bazar Patrika (a Bengali daily) with regard to an incident of fire outbreak in a slum during construction of a high-rise building.

Considering the gravity of the aforesaid incident, a report was called for from C.P., Bidhannagar.

It appears from the report forwarded by C.P., Bidhannagar that the land where the outbreak of fire had occurred, belongs to one Sabina Yasmin where 7 tenants were inducted in the 7 small huts. It is further reported that 4/5 tenants were injured in the said incident and one of them namely Nirmal Mondal had succumbed to injuries. It is further reported that the local PS informed the Forensic expert to ascertain the actual cause of the outbreak of the fire and the same was done on 13.01.19, but the report was not available till submission of the report. It is further reported that no complaint has been received by the concerned PS from any level but it has been instructed by the local PS that if any complaint is received by the said PS, that should be treated with a serious view and action should be taken without delay.
