



Memo No. 3832/E/HR dated 2/7/2020

On 08.02.2020, a news was published in ~~the~~ 'Bartaman' (a Bengali Daily) about the atrocity of the son and daughter-in-law of an old ^{widow} lady who took shelter at the house of her neighbour. According to the said news, they used to inflict torture upon her under a threatening that she would be arrested in connection with any false case ~~is~~ initiated by them and lastly they seriously assaulted her when she wanted to install ~~the~~ the C.C. T. V. out of her own savings and they drove her out from the house. It was also revealed in the said news that the son was arrested on the basis of her complaints.

The Hon'ble Commission took cognizance over the matter and a report was called for, from C.P., Barrackpore.

It appears from the report submitted before the Hon'ble Commission that the said lady namely Bimala

Khanna was subjected to mental and physical torture by her son and daughter-in-law in spite of the fact that she used to maintain her family from widow pension and by running a tailoring shop. However on the incident dated 07.02.2020, a case was started under Dum Dum P.S. case No. 92/2020 and after investigation, the said case has been ended in submission of charge sheet u/s 448/307/506/34 I.P.C.

In the circumstances as stated above the present case may be disposed of by passing an order which is stated as follows:

(Proposed order): The case initiated on the complaint of the victim has already been charge-sheeted and thus no further action is required in this case. Hence, the present case is disposed of.
