
Report of Inspector, I.W., WBHRC was examined. According to the report the enquiry was conducted in details by examining all the stake holders including sons of the deceased, the Medical Officer, Dr. Partha Banerjee who issued death certificate of Sk. Abdullah of of Velua vill, ^{at} and the police party, who were detail ^{at} for motor cycle patrolling duty ^{at} that day from 7 a.m. to 1p.m. and 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.

The police party did not go inside the village as it was about 4 k.m. distance from the main road. It was performing motorcycle patrolling duty on the main road.

Dr. Partha Banerjee, who issued death certificate after examining deceased, Sk. Abdulla stated that he was suffering from heart disease and was under his treatment. Sk. Abdulla died due to cardiac failure and there was no mark of external injury on his body.

Local villagers were examined who denied the allegation of lathi charge by the police in the village. Sk. Rajeshuddin, son of the deceased confirmed that his father expired at the residence after falling ill. This was further corroborated by other two sons of the deceased. They made no allegations against police personnel. Therefore, it clearly appears that the news ^{at} item is baseless. In view of above, I am of the humble opinion that the matter be filed.
