

Yesterday i.e. on 7th July, 2020 it was found at Ultadanga Garden Lane, No. 15 Bus Stand that a man named Pankaj Dey, aged about 60 years, was seriously ill lying on the road without wearing any dress. It was rumored in the area that the man was suffering from Corona. Police from Maniktala Police Station came there and learnt that the man was a resident of Arambag, in the district of Hooghly who was working as Security staff somewhere at Ultadanga and lost his job due to corona.

Considering the seriousness of the matter, the Commission has decided to take suo motu cognizance and directs the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Eastern Suburban Division to cause an enquiry into the matter and furnish a report to the Commission within 4 weeks from the date of communication of this direction.
