





Ruckus in MMCH over death of new born

MALDA, 23 JUNE

Malda Medical College and Hospital was in the midst of a turmoil this morning over the death of a new born. The family members of the deceased child staged an agitation against the authority for an alleged lack of treatment.

A written complaint has been made over the matter and an enquiry committee has been formed by the MMCH authority.

According to the sources, a housewife of Kotwali area under the English Bazaar P S, Jharna Basak Saha, gave birth to a boy on the 24 of this month and the new born was in a healthy condition till the last evening. ated a stir. The father of the deceased, Apurba Saha, alleged "Nobody could give us an idea what happened to my child and we could not meet the doctor. I want to know the circumstances under which the child died."

The deputy super of MMCH, Dr Jyotish Chandra Das said, "On the basis of a written complaint an enquiry committee has been formed to look into the matter. The report will be submitted within a week."
