Report of Shri Dipankar Bhattacharvya IPS SP WBHRC regarding visit of Behrampore Central Correctional Home, District Murshidabad on 26.05.2015.

I along with Inspector Shri T.C. Pal visited Behrampore Central Correctional Home on 26.05.2015 at about 11.30 hrs. During visit, we talked to Shri Nandan Kr. Barua, Superintendent, Dr. Avijit Nun, Dr. R.S.Prasad Ravi and other officers and staff. Discussed regarding present condition of that Correctional Home. Besides we prepared a check list for Behrampore Central Correctional Home which is as follows:-

Observation:-

- i) Overall ambience is good but there is enough room for improvement.
- ii) Aspect of Prison Security needs a beef-up.
- iii) Unfinished works of PWD needs to be completed soon.
- iv) Local Police may be requested by Prison Authority for Night Patrolling along the road surrounding the Prison.
- v) CCTV Cameras need to be made functional.
- vi) Full digitalization of Data may be completed soon.
- vii) Arrangement may be made for standby electricity.
- viii) More NGOs like DON BOSCO PRISON MINISTRY may be introduced for variety of Vocational Training Courses & also for Recreational / Educational Programmes.
