Apropos news items published in your esteemed paper dated 17.07.2015, I am directed to state the following facts.

It was very kind of your Paper to publish about the West Bengal Human Rights Commission's activities occasionally, but it was unfortunate that of late, most of the items are negative in nature.

- 2. In the instant case, it is not understood who are "several officials" who feels that the Complaint received by the Commission has come down due to erosion of faith in the panel and also what is the basis of this comparison. There are several reasons why complaints figures are not always up. I have complaints figures since it's inceptions with me and can tell you that complaints during 2014-15 are higher than the year 2011-12. Justice N.C. Sil was the head of the Commission at that point of time. Was there any erosion of complaints in the panel at that point of time?
- 3. To the alleged comments of the Hon'ble Acting Chairperson in which he has reportedly said that a number of complaints has come down and attributed this to the good job by the Government, it is to be clarified that the Chairman has categorically mentioned that "developmental activities" of Government has improved on account of which complaints relating to such activities have come down. It is a fact that Socioeconomic, educational and technological development is since qua non for reduction of Human Rights abuses and violations. It is job of the Government to frame good policy frameworks and implement them so that citizens get developed as in the case of Europe and U.S.A. and other advanced Countries.

4. Your Bureau refers five (5) incidents to prove right the charge of erosion of faith in the Commission. The Commission has taken cognizance of incidents through newspaper report(s) and through the complaints so received. For example, gang-rape incident of tribal girl at Labpur, Birbhum on January 19, 2014. Superintendent of Police was asked to submit the report and case was monitored by the State Human Rights Commission as well as by the National Human Rights Commission. Every stages of investigation, the Commission monitored right from filling of FIR, steps taken during investigation, examination of witnesses, statements recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. of the accused persons, scientific examination of the evidence and formation of SIT, steps taken for protection of witnesses and victim girls and action taken by civil administration, till Charge vide C.S. No.5/14 dated 17.04.2014 was submitted in Ld. Court of Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur and sentenced of the 13 F.R. named accused persons by Ld. Addl. District Judge, Bolpur to 20 years rigorous imprisonment of each on 20.09.2014. Regarding custodial death at Harish Chandrapur and Sattor incidents the Commission took due steps as appropriate.

It is very unfortunate that the news reporter mentions that the Chairman of Commission was unavailable for comments despite his best efforts. Herein, it may be mentioned none from Telegraph contacted the Chairman in office or otherwise. Furthermore, if the Chairman could not be contacted, Hon'ble Member, Principal Secretary, Special Secretary & P.R.O. are always available for giving clarification during office hours.

The Commission is very much aware of its duty and obligations, and will strive to detect and monitor Human Rights violations in the State, not only of Criminal nature but also of administrative lapses.
