The Commission took cognizance of a written complaint filed by Jayanta Chakrabyorty of Dum Dum, Kolkata praying for refund of caution money of college hostel and money of freeship of tuition fees of late Shirsa Chakraborty, Ex. B-Tech student of academic year 2012-13 who was the daughter of the complainant as the Bengal College of Engineering and Technology, Durgapur failed to solve the matter. A report was called for from the Higher Education Deptt. by this Commission.

By his letter dated 21.12.2015 the Joint Secretary of the Higher Education Deptt., West Bengal informed the Commission as follows:-

- 1. The College authority requested Sri Jayanta Chakraborty to collect his refund of caution money and other deposit amounting to Rs. 12000/- (except tuition fees) vide letter Ref. No. BCETW/SF-122605017202/14/04079 dated 13.10.2014 but he did not respond (Annexure "A").
- 2. The Director of Technical Education, West Bengal has also requested Sri Chakraborty to contact the college regarding refund of caution money vide Memo o. 1630(T) dated 19.11.2014 (Annexure "B")
- 3. Subsequently, the Director of Technical Education, West Bengal has again forwarded the prayer of Sri Chakraborty to the Principal, Bengal College of Engineering and Technology for Women vide Memo No. 1426-(T) dated 17.11.2015 thereby clearly mentioning him to refund the entire tuition fees as well as the caution money to Sri Jayanta Chakraborty (Annexure "C")
- 4. This Department has done all, as and when required.
